9 August 2024, (PHNOM PENH) - The opening ceremony of the first UK university campus in Cambodia was held yesterday the 8 August. De Montfort University Cambodia was honoured that the ceremony was presided over by **Samdech Moha Borvor Thipadei Hun Manet**, Prime Minister of the Kingdom of Cambodia.

In his welcome remarks, His Excellency Dominic Williams MBE, British Ambassador to Cambodia, said:
